I. APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS

2. Applicants must be a senior in high school or a college student with a cumulative GPA of 3.0 or higher.
3. In 350 words or less, clearly describe how you would like to impact the Harlem community; and how you would use the scholarship funds to further your education or training.
4. If selected, list what educational or training program you would like to attend. Provide specific dates, location(s), and expenses.
5. List if you have demonstrated interest in community affairs or extra-curricular activities.
6. Applicant must provide two letters of recommendation; one must be from a supervisor, faculty member or other individual knowledgeable with applicant's qualifications. Family members are ineligible.
7. The Scholarship Award is \$1000. **Applications must be postmarked by May 8, 2024, or delivered to HCCI Executive Office, 256 West 153rd Street, by 3:00 PM on Wednesday, May 8, 2024.**
